



Established as a single afternoon's race in 1839, Henley Royal Regatta has become internationally renowned as the largest racing regatta in the world. Winning at Henley is the pinnacle of a rowers career, and many of our world class Olympians have built their careers on this iconic stretch of The River Thames.
